

Guidelines for Poster Presenters

The three ICIAM 07 poster sessions will be held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday on the

floor E of the Foyer South in the Main Building (HG) of ETH Zurich; see the maps on [pages 2 and 3](#).

Each poster can be displayed for one day. During the refreshment breaks, that is, 10:30–11:15 and 15:15–15:45, the presenter (author) of the poster is advised to be available for questions and discussions.

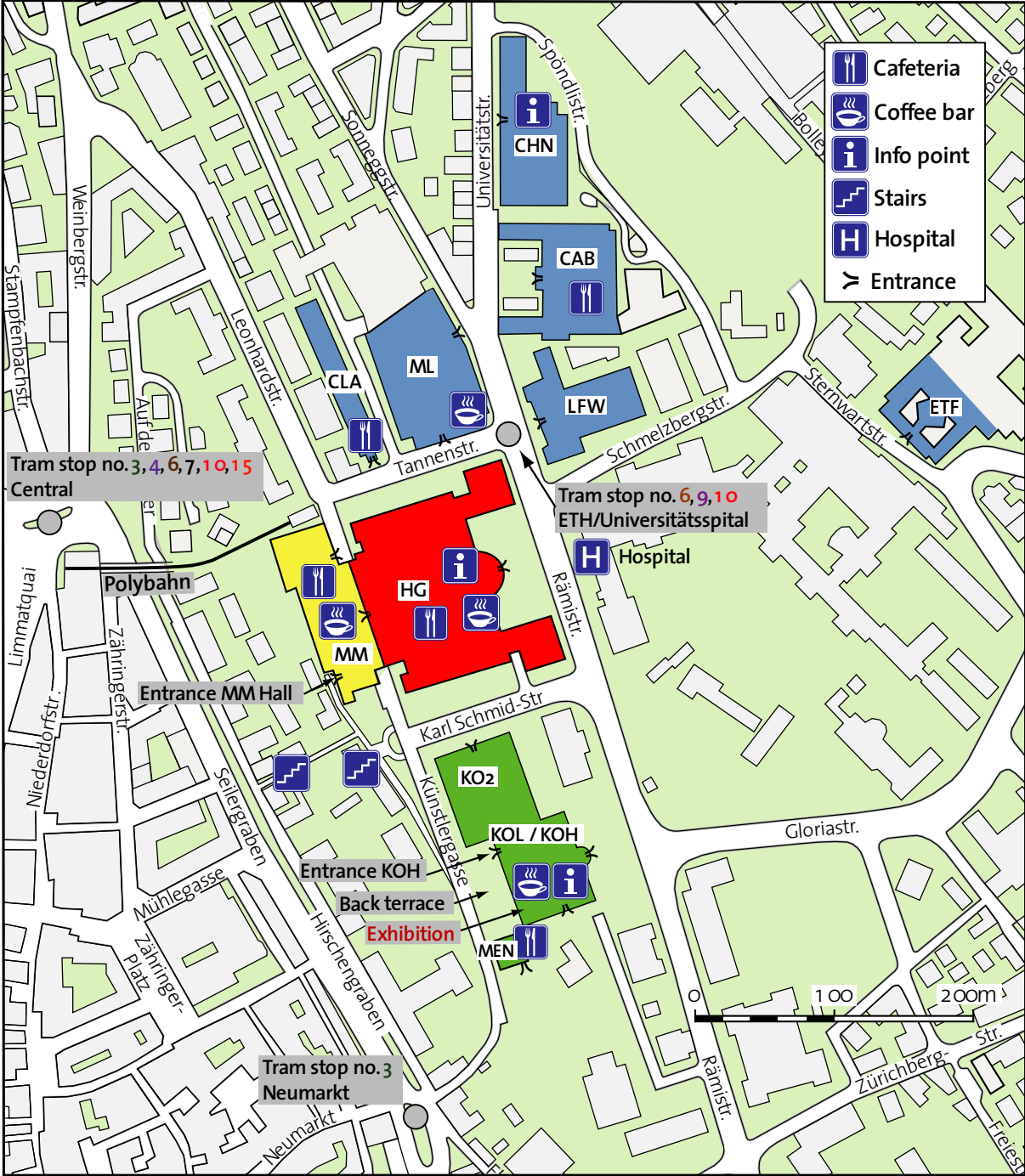
The poster boards are 120 cm wide and 180 cm high. We recommend a poster of maximum size

A0 (84.1 cm × 118.9 cm = 33.1 in. × 46.8 in.).

Organisation: Each poster can be displayed for 1 day. The poster stands are numbered from 1 to 50. Your number will be displayed on a list on site. Please hang up your poster on the stand with the correct number using the appropriate pins which we will provide. You can hang it up in the evening before your poster presentation from 19:00 (7 pm) till 20:00 (8 pm), or the next morning till 10:00 (10 am). During the refreshment breaks — see above — you should be near your poster. At other times you need not be there. Finally, you have to remove your poster before 18:15 (6.15 pm) in the evening.

Maps

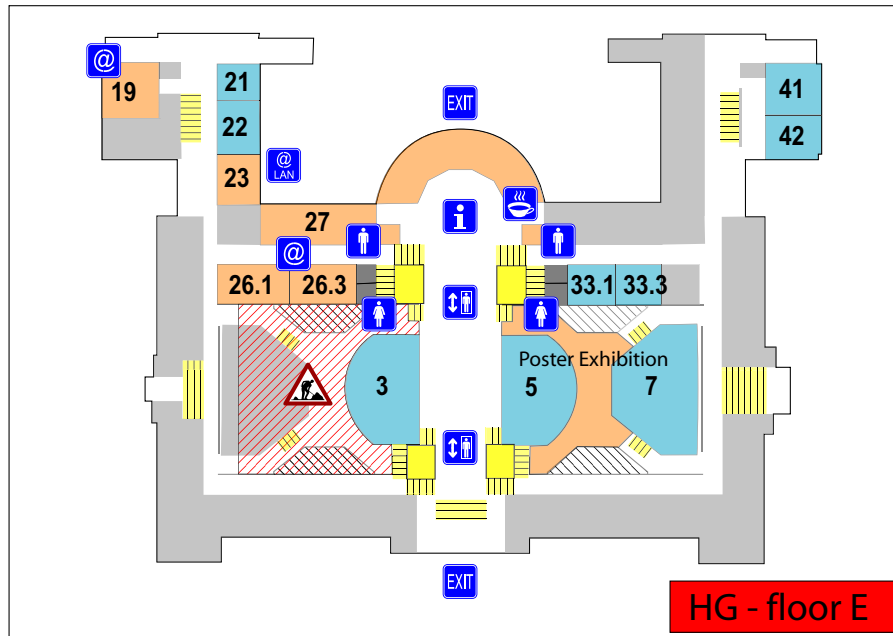
The following map indicates the various buildings in which the Congress events will take place. Also indicated are the closest tram stops and the *Polybahn* (cable car), which provide easy access to the site.

The following table describes the symbols and colours used in the maps.

Frequently the ground-floor (*Erdgeschoss*) or main entrance (*Eingang*) is designated as E level. Later/earlier letters denote higher/lower floors, respectively. (However not all buildings follow this rule.)
