

Herbert Edelsbrunner

He is Arts and Sciences Professor of Computer Science and Mathematics at Duke University. He founded Raindrop Geomagic (now Geomagic) with Ping Fu in 1996. He wrote two books in the general areas of computational geometry and topology, the first in 1987 with Springer-Verlag and the second in 2001 with Cambridge University Press. He received the Alan T. Waterman Prize from NSF in 1991, is elected member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences since 2005, and received an honorary degree from the Graz University of Technology in 2006.
